Information in a nutshell

All applications must be received by July 1st, 2011. Accepted applicants will be notified within two weeks (or less) of receiving applications. Applications not accepted will be returned along with uncashed fee check. The Elizabeth Celtic Festival Committee reserves the right to refuse any application. **Event Dates: Sat. & Sun., July 16 & 17, 2011.**

Fee for non-profit community organization space: \$25 for a 10' x 10' space (\$50 for a 20' x 10' space). Community Organizations may choose to come only one day or both days--the fee is the same either way. Application Deadline is July 1st, 2011. Each Community Organization will receive 4 tickets for each day, plus location map; this packet will be mailed on July 5th. We are now requiring most exhibitors and all competitors to pay for parking (\$2 per car, per day); thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

Self-Contained: Each Community Organization or similar organization must be self-contained--please bring your own tents, tables and chairs. Groups may sell memberships and group-specific merchandise. All organizations should have a canopy/tent and should also have a nice sign or banner naming your group. If you have a question, ask Wendy Hiserote (303-646-0152).

Check-in & set-up: Recommended check-in and set-up is on Friday afternoon, July 15th, starting at 4:00 p.m. (ending at 8:00 p.m.). In most cases you will be able to drive your vehicle next to your tent site to off-load. Everyone must check-in first before off-loading and setting up: Alana Wolner will be the check-in coordinator on the field.

Early Saturday morning set-up: Vehicle access for off-loading from 7:00-8:00 a.m. All vehicles must be off the grounds by 8:30 a.m.; "Gates open at 9:00 a.m." for the public. The normal main entrance to Casey Jones Park (next to the Pavilion Building) is access point for Community Organizations for Saturday morning, but there will be a lot of pressure at this entrance, so it's really important to have someone take your car back around to main parking area off of Road 17--you have to off-load and move--there will be many other cars coming in behind you. You absolutely can't set up your tent, then move your car...the car has got to go and get parked first. Access to your tent site may be not as convenient.

You must stay the whole day: If you come, you agree that you will stay until at least: 5:00 p.m. on Saturday and 4:00 p.m. on Sunday. No exceptions, please. Saturday will be a long day with evening hours until 8:00 p.m. Because of this, there will be no vehicle access until 8:00 p.m. Saturday (any vehicle access on Saturday evening will be from the arena area--this is different from the set-up access on Sat. morning early or Friday afternoon).
