

Sell Tickets to the Elizabeth Celtic Festival-- keep half the money for your group

We invite Community Organizations attending the Elizabeth Celtic Festival (2010 date of event: Sat/Sun, July 17 & 18-- "the Third Full Weekend of July"), and other designated Celtic-oriented non-profit groups to raise money by selling discounted tickets to the Festival.

- ◆ Sell advanced (discounted) spectator adult admission tickets for only \$8 and keep \$4 per ticket. Price at the gate on the day of the event is \$12.
- ◆ Likewise, sell Senior / Teen spectator admission tickets for only \$4 and keep \$2 per ticket. Price for Senior / Teens spectators at the gate on the day of the event is \$5.
- ◆ Children, age 12 & under are free.
- ◆ There are no "two day" tickets.

(No other discounts or promotions would apply or alter this program.)



All organizations involved with selling tickets for the Elizabeth Celtic Festival have to first send in their Community Organization registration fee of \$25. Tickets would be available on May 1st, 2010 (about 13 weeks before the Elizabeth "Games").

Organizations wishing to participate in this program would need to commit to the goal of a modest sale of 25 Adults tickets + 10 Senior/Teen tickets sold. That would amount to raising \$120 of revenue for your group. The potential, of course, is greater. Say that 100 Adult tickets are sold--that creates \$400 in revenue. All checks for tickets would be made out to the Community Organization or group selling the tickets, with one check from the organization going to the Elizabeth Celtic Festival Association on July 1st. If the Community Organization doesn't sell all the tickets, send back the unsold tickets with your check; you're only responsible for the tickets you sell or don't return.

You can sell these tickets to your Colorado area members, or to friends and family. Either way, this is a good way to help your Community Organization membership receive a benefit of lower priced tickets and to benefit your Community Organization with some revenue. Any individual costs of distribution (mailing, for instance) are the responsibility of the Community Organization or organization doing the selling.

Persons involved with raising funds by selling advanced discounted adult admission tickets will have small (half or quarter page) color fliers to show what the tickets are for and to help answer questions. This is the 18th year for the Celtic Festival in Elbert County, and our fifth year at beautiful Casey Jones Park in Elizabeth.

To participate this way, make sure to fill in the ticket-selling part of the Elizabeth Celtic Festival Community Organization Application.
