Athletic Heavy Events

Entry Fee: \$30 covers all entries in one class.

Registration: In advance by July 10, 2010, includes one gate pass, also competitors get an official Elizabeth Celtic Festival Athletes T-shirt, and lunch. Parking is not controlled by the Games Committee, so please just pay the \$2 at the parking entrance.

Field entries must buy their own gate passes (\$10) and pay a \$30 field entry fee--while you'll get lunch, T-shirts might not be available or in your desired size; Field entries accepted between 9:00-9:30 a.m. on competition day only if space is available.

Schedule: Posted by 9:00 a.m. each day; events will start at 9:30 a.m.

Classifications: Men's Open, Men's C, Women's Open, Men's Masters, Men's Under 190 lbs.

General Rules for All Athletic Competition:

- Competitors must be kilts. A few kilts will be available for a \$10 rental fee.
- Saturday events will include the Men's Open and Men's C and Women's Open
- Sunday events will include Men's Under 190 lbs. and Men's Masters (40 & over; scoring includes per year handicap).
- Athletes are allowed to compete in only one class.
- All warm-up throws must be completed prior to scheduled event start time.
- All competitors must be members of Rocky Mountain Scottish Athletes (RMSA) or an equivalent organization. RMSA membership forms will be available on the field.

\$30 for the competitor if you pre-register by July 10th. You get one ticket into the Festival. Many of you have brought several friends and family and it does help this festival. Thank you. You can pay only \$8 per adult for discounted advance tickets using this entry form.
