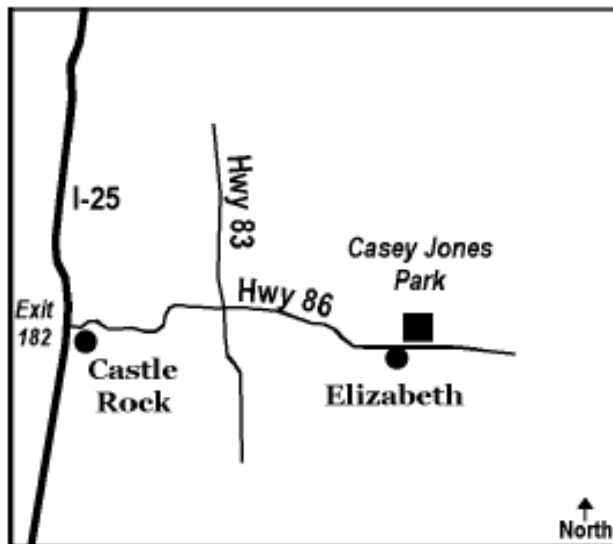

Please list the name(s) of the other dancer(s) in your duet or group on your entry form (after the entry number). Dance & music must be Celtic in theme, dancers should use movements from Highland and National dances, Jig, Hornpipe or Cakewalk with allowances for individual interpretation & variation. A limited influence from other dance forms such as Jazz, Tap, Ballet or step dances may be incorporated. Dance should not last longer than 3 minutes, including entrances & exits. Please provide a CD or tape of your music. You may also dance to a live piper. Intermediates may dance with either in the Pre-Premier category or the Premier category.

Competition Rules:

1. This competition will be conducted in accordance with S.O.B.H.D. regulations.
2. The decisions of the Adjudicator are final. Any attempt to talk to the judge during the competition will disqualify that dancer.
3. Highland dress will be worn in accordance with S.O.B.H.D. rules. Dancers must be in full costume to receive awards.
4. All dancers must have valid S.O.B.H.D. registration cards. No entry will be accepted without a current registration number. All dancers must present their Registration Card the day of the competition in order to compete.
5. **Entry Deadline:** All entries must be **received** by Friday, **July 8, 2011**. Entries are **LATE** if **received** after **July 8, 2011** & will be subject to a *late charge of \$10.00*.
6. Dancers will receive a gate pass **ONLY IF THEY INCLUDE A SELF-ADDRESSED, STAMPED ENVELOPE (S.A.S.E.) WITH THEIR ENTRY. OTHERWISE THEY WILL HAVE TO PURCHASE A TICKET AT THE GATE.** **NO** gate passes will be left at "will-call" at the gate.
7. Dancers not in the marshalling area when their class is called to dance will forfeit that dance.
8. Age groupings will be determined by the number of entries received. Ages will be computed as age on the day of competition.
9. Petitions should be filed to the dance chairman no later than 15 minutes after the end of the awards ceremonies. The petition should be in writing and be accompanied by a \$10 fee that will be refunded if the petition is warranted.
10. **Entry Fees:** Primary: \$12.00 per day (or \$5.00 per dance - whichever is less)
Beginners: \$30.00 (or \$5.00 per dance - whichever is less)
Novice, Intermediate & Premiers: \$30.00
Choreographies: \$3 per dancer per dancer per dance
(FUSTA receives \$1 from every dancer entry)
11. **Advance-Gate Ticket Sale for Highland Dancer families:**
(payment must be *received* by Friday, **July 8, 2011**\$8 Adults (**per day**)
& tickets will be mailed with dancer gate passes -- **YOU**.....\$4 Teens & Seniors* (**per day**)

12. **Prizes & Trophies:** Class medals & trophies will be presented at the end of each day of competition (Primary awards will be awarded at the completion of the Primary competition each day). Medals will be awarded to 3rd place in all classes (if warranted). There will be no trophies awarded at the Primary level. Class trophies will be based on all dances in that session.

Note: There will also be an award for the teacher with the most students competing at the Festival.
