New Vendor Info Sheet

Event Dates: Sat. & Sun., July 17th & 18th, 2010

Festival Location: Casey Jones Park, 4189 Highway 86, Elizabeth, CO
Casey Jones Park is on the east side of town. (Elizabeth 15 miles east of Castle Rock)

Vendor Deposit: \$200 in a separate check, to be returned to you when your space is left in a reasonably clean condition. This check will be forfeited if the vendor leaves before the end of the Festival or closes before vendor closing time either day.

Bring Everything You Need. All vendors must bring their own tent, tables and chairs and be prepared for outside conditions.

Responsibilities: The Elizabeth Festival Committee assumes no responsibility for any loses, damages or injuries. Each vendor must secure their belongings and merchandise to their satisfaction. The Elizabeth Festival Committee makes no warranties, either implied or expressed, regarding numbers of spectators or other conditions of selling and each vendor participates at their own risk. There will be no refunds made to vendors, once their applications are accepted.

All vendors must be open during the whole event and must stay for the entire event unless released by the Vendor Chairman.

All vendors must comply with state tax remittance regulations [we're just outside the City Limits for Elizabeth, so there is no local remittance]. For food vendors, you must comply with health regulations, as overseen by the Elbert County Health Department. Appropriate forms will be sent with the confirmation letter & parking pass.

Set-up: Beginning on Friday, July 16th at Noon. Check-in before you unload or set-up. You will be able to drive next to your tent site to off-load on Friday. No set-ups after 8:00 p.m. On Saturday, set-up will be less easy; vehicle access from 7:00-8:00 a.m. for off-loading; many clans will be attempting to come in on Saturday morning and it will be hectic. All merchandise vendors will be centrally located together along "British Lane" across from the "British Tent" (acoustic music) and the British Cars.

Electricity: There is no electricity available for merchandise vendors--it is allocated for five specific food vendor locations. If you are a food vendor needing any electricity (for refrigeration, or for your specific appliances), you must tell us exactly what your needs are (in terms of both voltage and how many amps you pull). Generators are expressly prohibited at this event.

Festival Hours: Sat.--9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. (yes, we're having evening events on Sat.).
[Vendors must stay open until at least 7:00 p.m. and may stay open until dusk, if you wish. We're are strongly discouraging vehicle access to the vendor area on Sat. evening because of the foot traffic possible with the evening concert and the Calling of the Clans torch-light ceremony, both of which are near vendor row.]
Sun.--9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

Take-down: The Festival ends at 4:00 p.m. Sunday. Vehicles can come in once it is safe to do so (**but not before 4:30 p.m.**).

Vehicle Parking, Camping, Tickets: Each vendor will receive four tickets for both days and a parking pass. If you wish to camp, reservations are taken on a first come, first served basis, and cost \$50 for RVs, Trailers or Campers ("things on wheels"), and \$20 for tents. If camping, make sure you include that on the form and in your check amount. **All individuals bringing in dogs that are not part of an animal booth, show or event, including Clan members, Vendors, Festival Participants, Volunteers, etc. must register their pets by filling out the Animal Application form (as appropriate) and signing The Waiver. See website for Animal Form, and send it in with your application.**
